Annual Review Update

NGO Relations is in the last stages of processing, reviewing and evaluating the **2016 Annual Review** submissions. We expect to have all the evaluations done by **cob Tuesday, 31 January 2017**. We will inform all NGOs on the results of the evaluation no later than **8 p.m. New York time, Tuesday 31 January 2017**.

If the evaluation of the Annual Review for your organization is positive, all designated representatives for your NGO will receive an e-mail with the necessary documentation and instructions on how to retrieve your grounds passes for 2017 starting **1 February**.

If the evaluation of the Annual Review for your organization is negative, your NGO will receive a message with information on how to prepare the 2017 Annual Review in order for the report to be approved, and what it means for your organization to have a negative Annual Review evaluation for this year.

Regardless of the evaluation results, **all designated representatives for all NGOs that submitted the 2016 Annual Review** will be included in the mailing list for this year 2017.
