## **Close the Gap**

Close the Gap is a non-profit organization which provides pre-owned computers donated by European companies to educational, medical and social projects in developing countries. They are associated with the Department of Public Information since January, 2016. Close the Gap collects decommissioned computers from companies and provides them to organizations that clean the hard disks according to the requirements of its end-users. They provide a sustainable approach for developing countries and other institutions through this process of distributing pre-owned computers, by extending the usability of the computers. They collect the equipment in a professional way at no cost to the donors. They are distributed throughout the world in different fields such as agriculture, education, environment/energy, health, youth care etc.
