Disability Association of Tavana

The Disability Association of Tavana (DAT) is a newly DPI associated NGO that was founded in 1995 and operates in Qazvin, Iran. DAT's founder and President, Seyed Mohammad Mousavi, is a handicapped Iranian himself who established the organization in hopes of improving conditions for the "ordinary disabled" in his country through targeting societal and governmental marginalization, and encouraging the expression and honouring of the disabled's own rights. DAT's work is especially unique in the developing world where discrimination against those in disabled conditions frequently leads to isolation within their communities and deprivation of rightful access to and utilization of their human rights. DAT offers wide range of services to address this neglect including educational, physical, and psychologically supportive programs.

This past March, DAT commemorated International Women's Day by teaming up with UNIC Teran and local officials to host a ceremony for fifty guests including handicapped students and mothers of children with disabilities. For the upcoming International Day for Persons with Disabilities on 3 December, DAT also plans to offer financial support to one hundred students and families struggling with disabilities.
