## **Global Bioethics Initiative (GBI)**

Global Bioethics Initiative (GBI) is a United States-based NGO focused on improving global health disparities through interdisciplinary research, public education, and policy change recommendations. Particularly, GBI aims to deepen international understanding and foster public debate on health, life science, biotechnological developments, and the frequent ethical issues that surround them. Moreover, GBI works to collaborate with policy makers and United Nations agencies to identify solutions and enact positive changes to pressing issues on the ground.

The organization is also very active on social media, sharing recent articles to update their followers on bioethical and life science-related innovations through their website, Twitter, and Facebook profiles. Annually, GBI also hosts an *International Bioethics Summer School* for high school seniors, undergraduate and graduate students, and professionals interested in such topics.
