UN Democracy Fund: Call for Project Proposals

The United Nations Democracy Fund (UNDEF) invites civil society organizations to apply for funding for projects to advance and support democracy. Project proposals may be submitted online **between 15 November and 31 December 2015** at www.un.org/democracyfund.

You can find guidelines, FAQs and lessons learned from previous rounds at www.un.org/democracyfund/application-materials (in English) and www.un.org/democracyfund/fr/application-materials (in French).

UNDEF supports projects that strengthen the voice of civil society, promote human rights, and encourage the participation of all groups in democratic processes. This is the Tenth Round to be launched by UNDEF, which provides grants of up to US\$300,000 per project. UNDEF has supported more than 600 projects in over 100 countries at a total amount of over US\$160 million. Proposals are subject to a highly rigorous and competitive selection process, with fewer than two per cent chosen for funding. Projects are two years long.

Inwelle Study and Resource Center, established in 2005, is a newly-associated DPI NGO that is committed to the empowerment of adolescent girls and at-risk youth. These goals are achieved through a number of educational, cultural, and vocational programmes which include life-skills training, computer skills trainings, encouraging research, providing educational counselling, and encouraging creative and scholarly pursuits. One of these programmes is an Academic Boot Camp for low income high-school girls in Enugu, Nigeria. For 30-days, the young women receive intensive lessons in Mathematics, English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and other academic subjects that reflect their interests and abilities with the aim of preparing them for higher education.
