The NGO/DPI Executive Committee, an eighteen member elected body, represents your interests as Non-Governmental Organizations associated with the United Nations Department of Public Information (DPI). The Executive Committee, which acts in an advisory and liaison capacity with DPI, meets at the UN Headquarters in New York each month, from July to June to discuss matters of interest and concern to NGOs associated with DPI. It is now conducting its annual elections.

You are casting your vote for the New Term of the NGO/DPI Executive Committee which begins 1 August 2017 to 30 June 2019. Candidates' biographies as well as the ballot are attached (also on the website of the NGO/DPI Executive Committee: www.ngodpiexecom.org).

Please complete your ballot indicating your choices for one (1) Chair position, One (1) Officer's positions (Secretary)and seven (7) Director Positions. **Votes will be** disqualified if submitted by more than 1 authorized person per NGO or includes more than the number of allotted candidates per position.
